Week commencing 10th June



This week we will be looking at Food Chains and Nutrition as we start to join up what we learnt last term about plants and animals. We have lots of activities based around the sun, the plants, the animals that eat the plants and predatory

animals that will support our understanding of the world, communication and language skills and our maths. Our 'snack café' will be open for the children to create their menus and take it in turns to be a customer (consumer) or server. We will look at where our foods come from (source) and hear the tale about the 'Little Red Hen' who milled her flour from an ear of corn and made some bread. On Tuesday we will make our own bread and try this with honey. We will talk about bees and how they make our honey and look carefully in the garden for bees collecting nectar. We will also look at the effects of food on our bodies and the importance of healthy choices as we understand about our physical development. Sponges will be used to show how water is absorbed and how the sun dehydrates living things and we will measure the effects on our bodies during timed physical activities.
