Stomp into the lost world of dinosaurs this week as we complete our Living Things topic by looking back at animals which have become extinct.

Help free our dinosaur figures from their eggs made of ice and move them to our swampy sensory habitat using tweezers. We will read about dinosaurs and practise our counting with 'Dinosaur Roar' a book by Paul and Henrietta Stickland. This counting will be put into action during focus time when the children will add the correct number of peg spines to our dinosaur cut outs. There will be a dinosaur song with actions for the children to learn during group time. In the garden we will have a number trail using dinosaur footprints, the children will have to follow the numbers in order to reach the hidden treasure. We will also play a game of 'What's the time Mr Dinosaur?' and have a dinosaur dig in the sand. We will discuss what happened to the dinosaurs and get creative in our art corner with paint and craft straws to make dinosaur fossils. In Literacy we will use tracing paper to trace around dinosaur pictures to improve our pencil control.
